PROGRAM

WACO - Maternity Group Home (MGH), Transitional Living Program (TLP II)

PROGRAM GOAL: To provide housing and supportive services to homeless pregnant and/or parenting young adults, ages 16 through the age of 21, for a period not exceeding 18 months. Participants ages 16 & 17 are placed at Option House Shelter for housing assistance.

QUALIFYING CRITERIA

- Must be homelessness or have an eviction notice of pending homelessness (may be provided from a third party or directly from individual currently residing with)
- Must be pregnant and/or parenting
- No felonies or sexual assault charges
- Must submit a completed application and interview
- May have only two children
- Must demonstrate ability to function and make decisions concerning own safety with minimal supervision (due to not being a 24 hour on-site staffed facility)

SERVICES PROVIDED

- Fully furnished apartment
- Monthly bus pass
- Grocery & hygiene assistance
- Life Skills
- Case Management
- Employment & Educational services (including applications, enrollments, uniforms, & supplies)
- Pre-residential Services (assistance provided to get state identification)
- Assistance in getting necessary state identification
- Non-residential Services (same services offered in an attempt to stabilize housing for residential applicant if TLP housing units are currently full)

PROGRAM LIMITATIONS

Referrals to Drop-In Center services for Non-residential and post-residential services available for applicants identified as potential TLP & MGH residential clients.

RENTAL PAYMENT

Rental payment is set, based off of income, at each lease renewal. The payment is due via money order to program staff at the beginning of each month. Upon discharge from the program the participant will receive a reimbursement for all rental payments made minus expenses for property damage.
